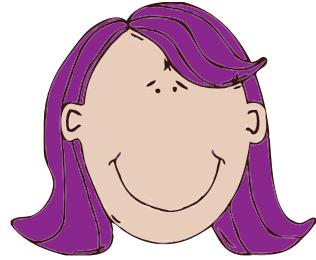
Try printing on cardstock, they will last longer

cut the back flap here if you don't want the full cover over the top.
glue back flap to the inside of the sides when folded to the back

How to make the pocket wallet:

- Cut out around the colored edge
- Score the white dashed lines
- Fold along the lines
- Place your cards inside the wallet and fold the back flap up to the top of the cards and over them.
- Fold the sides in. Mark where they cross.
- Glue or tape the sides.
- Either make a slit in the front to put the front flap into, or glue a small piece of velcro to the flap and card deck to secure it closed.
- Make sure to not make it too tight around the cards so you can easily take them in and out.
